You might be interested in a March, 2021 article in the Journal of the American Dental Association: Longitudinal Caries Prevalence in a Comprehensive, Multicomponent, School-based Prevention Program.

This article reviews data from the first school-based dental program established by Dr. Richard Niederman, a distinguished professor and epidemiologist who serves as the Co-Director of the World Health Organization Collaborating Center for Quality-improvement Evidence-based Dentistry.

The authors conducted a 6-year prospective open cohort study in 33 US public elementary schools

providing care to over 6000 children in communities with & without Fluoridation.

Conclusions and Practical Implications: This school-based comprehensive caries prevention program was associated with substantial reductions in children's untreated caries (50%), supporting the concept community-based aerosol-free care.

You will be very proud to know that Dr. Niederman is our valued advisor who guided us in the founding of RSS. With this program, we have developed a dental home that is without walls, in the community and serving the children who otherwise would have no access to dental care.
